STUDENT CARE

Safeguarding is one of our top priorities. Our student services team are available to ensure the safety, well-being, and protection of all students at any time during opening hours or on our 24-hour emergency contact number when the centres are closed. Our staff receive regular training on first aid, fire safety and care of under 18s.

We offer courses for both adults and teenagers. As such, additional support is in place for under 18s. This includes:

- A 24-hour emergency contact number
- A parental consent form clearly communicating what we offer and obtaining permissions
- Special measures around airport arrivals
- A special selection of accommodation
- Assistance to access under 18 discounts e.g. for travel
- Tracking presence and attendance
- Rules to keep young people safe e.g. curfews
- Information on health and medication
- Advice on which social programme events they can attend

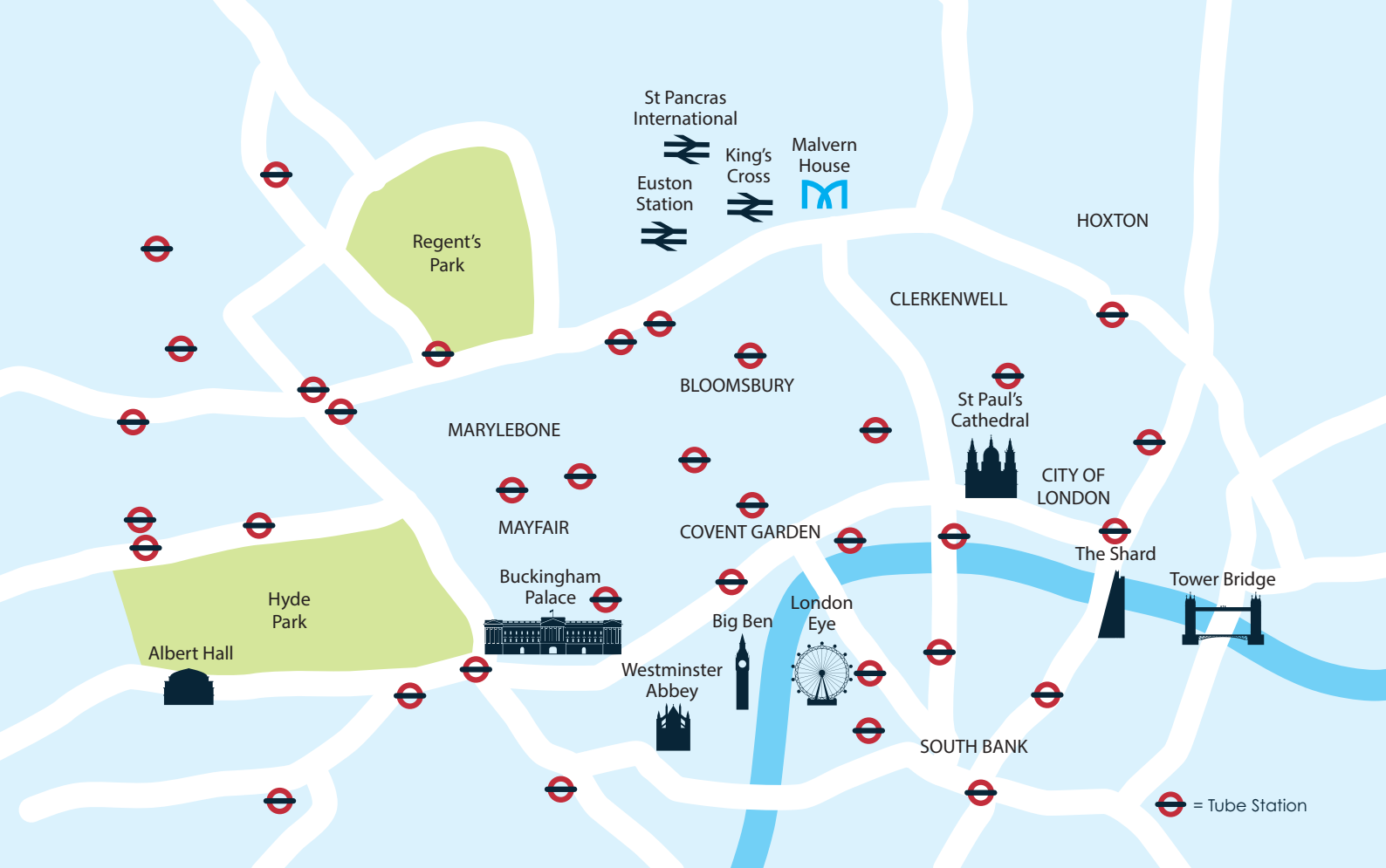

Manchester is a major city in the North West of England, approximately half way between London and Edinburgh, with easy access to the rest of the UK.

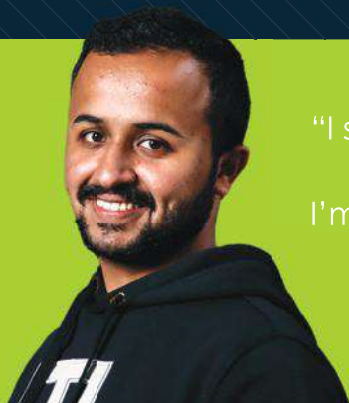
